Bella Laminati LLC markets its products throughout US, Mexico and Canada. Bella Laminati Decorative Laminates are manufactured at one of our state of the art, international manufacturing facilities exclusively for Bella Laminati and our distribution partners.

3. General Description: Bella Laminati Laminates are composed of a layer of Melamine impregnated decorative paper bonded to layers of phenolic impregnated Kraft paper. The backside of the laminate is sanded to ensure uniform bonding and consistent thickness.

- **Sheet sizes:** 4' x 8' or 4' x 10'
- **Availability:** All Bella Laminati Decorative Laminates shown within our Binders and Chain Sets are stocked in New Jersey.
- **Thickness Available:** Bella Laminati HPL is available in .8 mm (.032") thickness, (Post-Forming Grade). Bella Metallics are available in .9 mm (.035") or 1.0 mm (.040") thickness, (Standard and/or Post-Forming Grade). Bella Solid Core is available in 1.2 mm (.048") thickness, (Standard Grade).
- **Basic Uses:** Bella Laminati Decorative Laminates are recommended for interior vertical and horizontal decorative applications. Possible uses are wall panels, cabinet doors, store fixtures, tradeshow booths, furniture, countertops, columns, and cash wraps.
- **Not recommended For:** Areas exposed to high temperatures, or exterior use.

4. Installation: Bella Laminati Decorative Laminate can be bonded to the following substrate materials: MDF Board, HDF Board, Flake Board and Particle Board. Material should be installed in conformance with basic techniques outlined by NEMA LD-3 for high pressure laminate; or as recommended by your adhesive manufacture.

5. Post-forming Grade: Bella Laminati Decorative Laminates are available in 0.8mm (.032”) post-forming grade for vertical & horizontal furniture applications.

6. Balancing: We recommend that all Bella Laminati Decorative Laminates are adhered to a substrate should be balanced with an equally thick Phenolic backer (or similar) to help ensure a proper balance to keep finished boards flat.

7. Care and Maintenance: Bella Laminati Decorative Laminates should be cleaned with a particle free, clean, non-abrasive, damp cloth. Mild soap and water or mild liquid detergent can be used. **Do not use:** solvents, abrasive cleaners, steel wool, powder soap, harsh chemicals, acids or alkaline cleaners. These products may cause scratching and/or surface discoloration.

8. Material Warranty: Bella Laminati warrants and represents our Products are free of defects in material and workmanship. This is the only warranty or representation, and the sole basis for liability respecting quality, performance, defects, repair, delivery and replacements of the Products.

9. Claim of Defects: In the event of a defect in material or workmanship in Products sold hereunder, Bella Laminati LLC will replace the same, f.o.b. point of shipment. Bella Laminati’s liability (except as to title) arising out of the sale, use or operation of products, whether on warranty, contract, negligence or otherwise (including claims for consequential or incidental damages) shall not in any event exceed the cost of furnishing a replacement for the defective Product as herein provided. In order for a claim of defect to be made and accepted by Bella Laminati LLC, Buyer must notify Bella Laminati LLC within thirty (30) days of receipt of Products, time being of the essence. In addition, Bella Laminati shall not replace Products post-installation. It shall be Buyer’s and/or Installer’s duty and obligation to inspect the Products prior to installation. Bella Laminati will not cover labor costs associated with replacement of Products.

10. Restocking Fee: There will be a 25% restocking fee for all material returned within 30 days from original date of purchase. Returner will be responsible for all associated packaging and freight costs. Sheets must be sufficiently protected to prevent damage during transit. Credit will not be issued for sheets that are returned damaged.
